

Administrative Organization, Authority, and Responsibility

The board endorses an administrative organization known as the "single executive" type of school administration wherein the board acts as the elected governing body and places all school district functions and programs under the direction of the board's chief executive officer, the superintendent of schools.

The superintendent and administrative staff are authorized to, and responsible for, designing, implementing, managing, and evaluating programs and activities that culminate in an effective educational experience for the district's students. In so doing, the board expects that all administrators will work within established board policy and school-related statute, be appropriately trained and certified, and be skilled in communicating and problem solving.
